News from Around the Temple...

New Saladin Petition Includes Comprehensive Background Investigation

As many of you learned at our September Stated Meeting, a routine background investigation completed as part of a Noble's request to become a volunteer hospital driver turned up a number of questionable items in the Noble's past including 4 Felony convictions, 2 for violent assaults and 2 for fraud, as well as other misdemeanor convictions. Further investigation suggested the matters were not adequately disclosed to his Blue Lodge or the Shrine during the petitioning process. As the Shrine had no existing power to enforce a standard that exists at the Blue Lodge level, the Potentate did provide the relevant information related to the brother to the Grand Master of Masons in Michigan and the Grand Master took no action that would allow Saladin to remove him from our rolls or otherwise address the matter. Therefore he is still a member of Saladin Shriners. As a result of this event, the Saladin Board of Directors voted to adopt a new Shrine petition (included in this issue of the News). It includes a portion providing for a comprehensive background investigation of each petitioner to Saladin Shriners. All future petitions for initiation, affiliation and restoration will require this portion to be completed by the candidate. Though this is a matter previously entrusted to the Blue Lodges in our jurisdiction, the aforementioned incident necessitates this action on Saladin's part. Please contact the Recorder with any questions you have. Any petitions turned in that do not include this portion will be incomplete until a signed release is received.
