I think that we should have Nobles from as many different clubs as possible involved in this project.

I have received a number of inquires to purchase items from the temple. It is our intention to have an auction to



sell the property. We may list some of the items on the Internet for advance purchase. These would be items that are business specific, such as the commercial dishwasher or the appliances, old office equipment, etc. In other words, the big ticket items that might fetch far more in a specialized sale than they would a one-day auction. Once we have decided on which items we are listing, we will publish that information in the Saladin News.

Carla and I would like to thank Ill. Sirs Tom Wells and Coby Martin for their services during the installation. We look forward to a GREAT year and an increase in membership in 2013.

Due to the several vacancies we have had in the moving line during

the last few years, Ill. Bro. Archie was kind enough to step in and serve as Assistant Rabban for the 2013 year to allow our two junior Divan officers a year to develop the experience necessary for the higher chairs. It is not intended that he will advance through the line again.

Of the business at hand, the most notable decision made by the membership was the motion made by Ill. Bro. Coby Martin, P.P., to negotiate the sale of our Shrine Temple based on the counteroffer received from the buyer. The motion passed unanmously.

The Potentate's budget for the 2013 year was approved. Several clubs presented checks for the support of our philanthropy.

There being no additional business, the meeting was adjourned and followed by an installation of our 2013 officers.

Treasurer reports good financial shape entering 2013

We begin the New Year travelling on a new path. 2013 will bring significant changes to our usual way of operation, beginning with this year's circus.

As you have been informed, our income will be derived from Circus Ad Sales, Circus Program Sales, and School Ticket Sales, all of which depend upon our effort and enthusiasm. We need to get behind all of these projects, particularly the Program Ad Sales, which need to be in by February 1, so the time is now to get the ads wrapped up!

We begin the year in good financial shape, as we have avoided paying the deposit money for the Deltaplex. The dues response has been good, and we will be sending out second notices in the next two weeks.

Completed building sale puts Saladin on the move

On January 10th, Potentate Scott signed the Counteroffer from the Buyer of our property. Accordingly, the clock has begun ticking for our move out of the building.

Under the terms of the agreement, the buyer has 120 days to complete their zoning change and other preparations for the building of the condo project.

If all is concluded, we will then close the sale. At that point, we will have 90 days to vacate (60 days on the back buildings) If all goes on schedule, we will be out of here as of August 10th or so.

While that sounds like a lot of time, it really isn't. There is much to be done to clear out our equipment and necessary items to use in the future.

First of all, we have to decide what we will need in the years to come, and to then dispose of what we don't want or need. The Potentate wants to have a sale, similar to a giant garage sale, which would be open to the public. Just how the sale will proceed has not yet been decided. We are going to be advised by someone who is a professional in these matters to try to maximize our return. We will make the membership aware of the details as they are decided.

As you know, the recent changes in the Invested Reserve bylaw provides that all proceeds from the building sale and the personal property will be put into our Invested Reserve, subject to the terms and conditions that are contained therein.

If any Noble has an interest in any of the Temple items, we are requesting that you send us a written statement of such interest, and some kind of idea as to how much you would be willing to pay. We will not hold you firmly to any such statement, but we would like to get some idea as to how you would value the item, as many of these things are unique, and do not have any general commercial value.

We will be clearing everything out, including furniture and fixtures, and all the kitchen appliances and gear, including the dishes and silverware, bowls, pots and pans.

We will continue to keep you advised as the preparation develops. If you have questions, please contact the Recorder, Rick Williams, for information or to submit a statement of interest.

Several fixes in the works for Saladin email list

Part of the problem has been caused by the way the office was previously sending the emails. It is possible that prior Saladin emails may have triggered a few SPAM filters. We've recently corrected the source of the problem by adopting a new system to handle our mass email communications. If you believe you are still not receiving temple emails, we ask that you first check the 'Spam Folder" of your email program to see if Saladin emails are being placed there. If so, it is necessary that you flag the emails as not being SPAM. If you find nothing in your Spam folder, please contact your Club secretary or the main Saladin office to check to see if we have the proper email address in our system to contact you.

At the club level, what are your meetings and events like? Is there so much levity that you have to call order to the Nobles to stop the




Dan Soullier - Chief Rabban 2013 with his Lady Tabitha

We will be sending public service information out to radio stations, community access television stations and news papers concerning our events, parades, clinics, etc.

We will be seeking photo opportunities with children and families that we sponsor to the hospitals, camps and to those that we grant requests to from our trust.

Any Club or Unit that makes a donation to charity is being requested

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to get as much publicity as possible for their contribution. There are limits on what we can do pursuant to Imperial Law so please check with Ill. Sir Jeff before publishing anything.

Any Noble that has an idea concerning how best to get our name and image out to the public should contact a Divan member or the Public relations chairman.

The highlight of the public relations campaign will be the jurisdiction wide paper sale that we will be conducting on the weekends of August 2-4 and August 9-11. The Battle Creek Shrine Club has conducted a paper sale for some time on these dates and Arnie Fenrich is the chairman of their event. Rather than reinvent the wheel, Arnie has agreed to be the chairman of the jurisdiction wide paper sale for the temple. All income from the paper sale must go to the hospitals pursuant to Imperial Law. The general concept here is to have one paper that is sold everywhere. I encourage each club and unit to designate a local paper sales chairman who will be responsible for collection of the advertising and information for inclusion in their portion of the paper.

The temple will also be purchasing shrine baseball style hats for the Nobility to wear in public when a Fez is not appropriate. These will be available soon and sold at cost. In addition, we will be purchasing items to be given out at the parades throughout the year. These are small hand held collapsible fans that can be used over and over. The trust will be purchasing these items and they will have a Fez on them and information about how to help a child in need as well as how to make a donation to the trust and the hospitals.


